A deposit is required with booking (£50 per person deposit for an RYA course). The balance is payable 14 days before the course starts. Cheques should be payable to 'The Polkerris Beach Company' and sent to The Polkerris Beach Company, The Pilchard Store, Polkerris, Par, Cornwall, PL24 2TL

Participants should be on-site at least 15 minutes before the session start time and should be ready to leave 15 minutes after the session end time.

Cancellation by the customer. In the event of cancellation, notice must be received prior to 7 days of the session/course start date. A cancellation fee of £20 will be charged. There will be no refund for cancellations within 7 days, or if you do not arrive for the course. If you have to postpone a course, we will try to arrange a mutually convenient alternative date but reserve the right to charge a fee.

Cancellation by the Polkerris Beach Company. We reserve the right to cancel or postpone courses in the event of extreme conditions or other factors beyond our control. In this event, the course will be rearranged for a mutually convenient date.

Conditions of participation. Participants must be able to swim 40m and be confident in the water. Any medical condition that may affect participation must be notified prior to the start of the course, using the space provided above. Note that we may decline to award a certificate for a course, but will always give a reason and an action plan.

Safety. In addition to enjoyment and learning new skills, safety is of paramount importance. While watersports have a very good safety record, they are hazardous by their nature and the

Polkerris Beach Company operates to well-defined procedures designed to manage the risk inherent in them. However, participants must accept that risks exist and that bumps and scrapes can happen from time to time.

Insurance. The Polkerris Beach Company has public liability insurance for activities operated by the company. Personal insurance against loss, damage, injury or accident whilst visiting the site is the responsibility of the individual.

Supervision. Participants under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
